[Rebuild Foundation](#)'s mission is to demonstrate the impact of innovative, ambitious and entrepreneurial arts and cultural initiatives. At the core of the Foundation's mission is supporting artists and strengthening communities through free arts programming, creating new cultural amenities, and developing affordable studio and community space. The Stony Island Arts Bank serves as headquarters for Rebuild Foundation's network of cultural amenities on the South Side and as home for the foundation's archives and collections. Designed by William Gibbons Uffendell and built in 1923, the bank at 68th Street and Stony Island Avenue was once a vibrant community savings and loan. In 2015, Rebuild Foundation's Founder Theaster Gates radically restored the building, which now serves as a

space for neighbors to preserve, access, reimagine and share their heritage. Rebuild Foundation's sites provide a destination for artists, scholars, curators, and collectors to research and engage with South Side history.
